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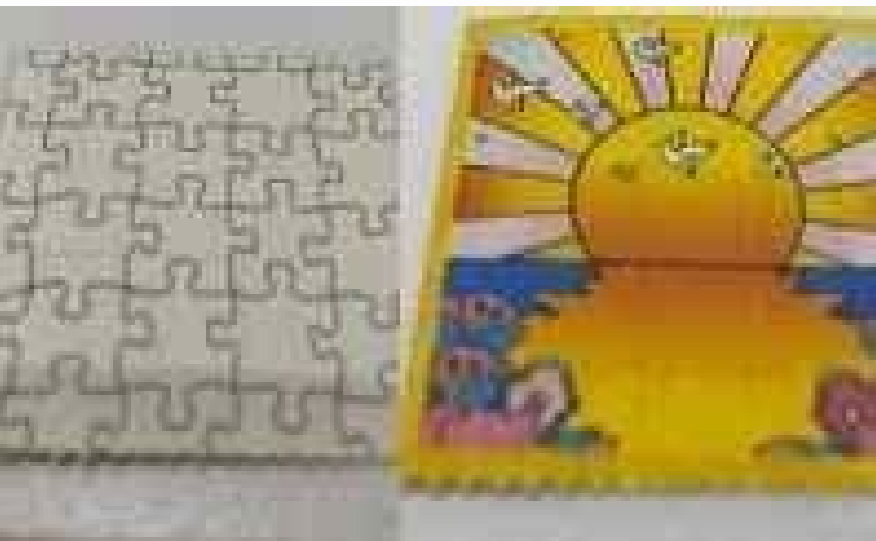

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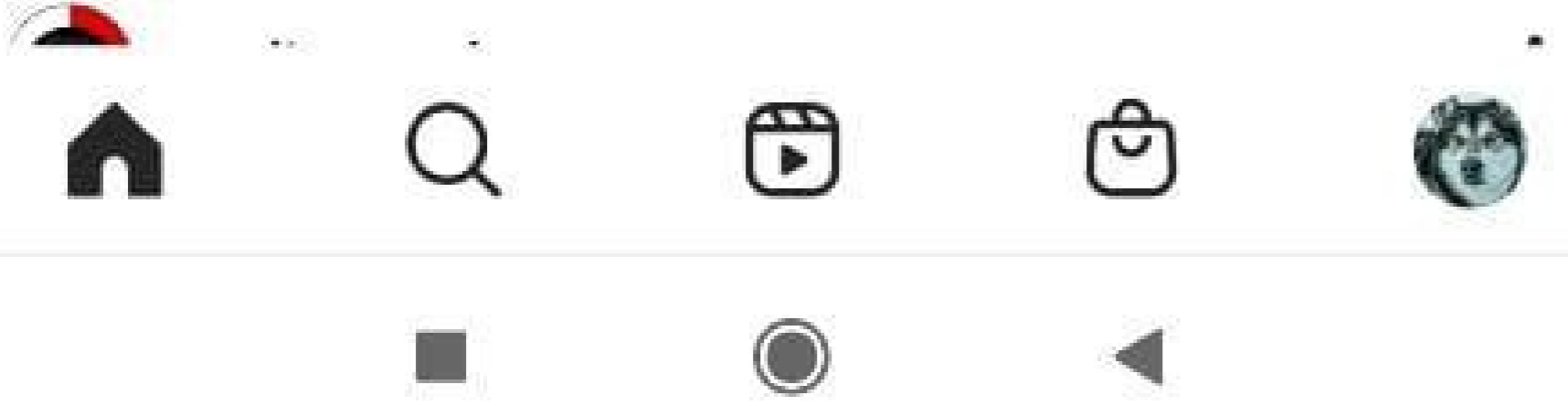

The Benedictine Abbey dates back to the 9th century and legend has it that this was once was home to the Holy Grail.**PRO TRAVEL TIP:** Middy, lines can be long to enter the monastery and see the Black Madonna. For the best views while at Montserrat, consider doing this 3 hour return hike. Come take look if you are curious but don't expect to climb it.A Montserrat day trip from Barcelona takes a good part of a day. The cable car typically runs every 15 minutes but can run as frequently as every 5 minutes depending on number of passengers.Riding the train and cable car round trip costs €23. Buses leave the Estacio Sants train station for Montserrat. Allow an hour for the entire walk.Santa Cova Chapel | Montserrat day trip from BarcelonaIf you look closely, you can see the trail to the Santa Cova Chapel snaking its way along the mountainside.Santa Cova funicular | Montserrat day trip from BarcelonaThis is another beautiful walk. This is Catalonia's most important religious retreat, as many people make an overnight hike to watch the sunrise from the peak of Montserrat.The view from Montserrat | Montserrat Day Trip from BarcelonaFor some people, a visit to Montserrat is a religious pilgrimage. Visiting Montserrat is one of the most popular day trips from Barcelona. Expect to spend all day here if you want to hike the trails and/or sit down to lunch or dinner.Restaurant Hostal Abat Cisernos. The journey by train takes approximately one hour and costs €5.75 one way (€11.50 for a round trip ticket). The views from the chapel are stunning. Travel time takes about 1.5 hours one way (roughly one hour for the train and 30 minutes for the cable car or rack railway). All of the artifact and historical treasures were lost in this attack. Here is a link to ticket price PDF.From Aeri de Montserrat, take the cable car to the top. This is the most expensive option. There are much better things to see while in Montserrat, such as the Monastery, the views from the various viewpoints, and the Santa Cova Chapel. Three hundred years ago a chapel was built at this spot.From the monastery, take the Santa Cova funicular down to the walking trail. You can click the check marks to hide or show layers. Now a fence surrounds it, both for safety reasons and because it is a work of art. On Google Maps, the Stairway to Heaven is called Escala de l'enteniment (click here to see the location on Google Maps). This walk takes you to a higher point than the Santa Cova Chapel, for more stunning views of the valley and an awesome view back to the monastery.Finding the trailhead can be a little tricky. From the train station, walk through the town of Monistrol to trails winding their way up the mountain. Depending on the time of your visit, there can be two lines to enter the church: one to get up close to the Black Madonna and touch the sphere that she is holding, and one to enter the church. Ride the train from Barcelona and take your pick between riding the cable car or the rack railway to the monastery. Its intention was never to be a jungle gym.Numerous people visit Montserrat just to see the Stairway to Heaven. For others, it's a visit to a unique mountain range offering views over Catalonia.Be whisked to the top by a scenic cable car ride, take short hikes through the mountain peaks, and take a funicular higher up onto the mountain for even better views.Those who enjoy hiking can walk to Sant Jeroni, the highest peak of Montserrat.Montserrat Monastery | Montserrat day trip from BarcelonaGetting from Barcelona to Montserrat is quick and easy. To view it on your phone or computer, open Google Maps, click the menu button, go to "Your Places," click Maps, and you will see this map on your list.This is the quickest and most scenic option. In our opinion, this is an overrated attraction. The best option may be to assemble a picnic lunch at Boqueria Mercado before making the journey out to Montserrat.Another view of Montserrat | Montserrat day trip from BarcelonaHere are several highly rated tours from Barcelona that include your transportation. If you have no desire for a close up view of the Black Madonna, make sure that you are in the correct line. It was hardly worth the visit.If you have plans to visit Montserrat for the sole reason of climbing the Stairway to Heaven, you should know that it is illegal to do so.The Stairway to Heaven is located just east of the Mirador Restaurant. This hike gives you the best views over Catalonia.We did not hike to Sant Jeroni, but I wish we did. The queue to see the Black Madonna moves very slowly and you can literally wait hours in line. L'Esconia Montserrat, the Boys Choir, is famous for their world-renowned performance. While at Montserrat, you get unlimited rides on the Sant Joan funicular, admission into the Montserrat Museum, and one meal at the self-service restaurant. When you purchase your round trip ticket from the Plaça Espanya station in Barcelona, make sure you specify whether you plan to take the cable car or the rack railway. This costs €8 one way, €12 for a return ticket. These tickets are not interchangeable.Trans Montserrat TicketThis is a combination ticket that includes round trip transportation from Barcelona, a round trip ride on either the cable car or the rack railway, two round trip funicular rides on Montserrat, and two metro rides. The first performances date back to 1223. For hours of the monastery, click here. To avoid waiting in a long, plan to arrive to the monastery at or near opening time. Located inside of the monastery is a statue of the Virgin of Montserrat, one of the few black madonnas of Europe. Combined tickets can be purchased at the Plaça Espanya station in Barcelona.Get updated prices and check the cable car timetable here.This option is slightly longer than taking the cable car, since you go ride the train from Barcelona one station farther than Aeri de Montserrat. Tim was racing Ironman Barcelona in just a few days so we didn't want to hike too much. Some tours also include a visit to a winery.By BusThis is a less popular option, since most people make the journey by train. It takes about an hour and a half to do this hike, the views are wonderful, and there is something special about arriving at the monastery on your own two feet. This costs €8 one-way or €12 for a return ticket (these are high season prices, which includes the summer months, some holidays, and some weekends). The train and railway round trip starts at €23.00. From Plaça Espanya in Barcelona, take the R5 line to Monistrol de Montserrat. A visit here is free and it is said that the statue of the Virgin Mary and her infant son have healing powers. Combined tickets can be purchased at Plaça Espanya.For timetables and ticket prices, visit the Cremallera de Montserrat website.Important Note: It is the same price to take the cable car or the Cremellara rack railway to Montserrat. They perform in the Basilica of Montserrat. To return to Barcelona, take the cable car or the rack railway, and then ride the train back to Barcelona.Tickets can be purchased from the Barcelona Tourism website. If you click the icons on the map, you can get more information about each point of interest. But first, here is a map of Barcelona and Montserrat. If you click the star next to the title of the map, this map will be added to your Google Maps account. People would travel to Montserrat just to take a photo on top of the Stairway to Heaven. At one time, this was a popular object to climb. Ticket prices start at €53.85 per person with children under 4 being free. Aktiviera JavaScript for att se Google Maps. This adds up to 6 hours (3 hours transportation time + 3 hours at Montserrat). During our visit, the Stairway of Heaven was protected behind a hastily erected construction fence. After a long restoration process, the monastery reopened in the mid-19th century. In the early 1900's, this museum opened. For lunch or dinner you can have a three course meal for €27.50.Cafeteria. This takes out the hassle of arranging your transportation and you can visit the monastery with an experienced guide. It's easy to get to and gives you an opportunity to see the Spanish countryside. "Montserrat" translates to "saw mountain" in Catalan, owing to this mountain range's jagged, sawtooth appearance.Sitting atop the mountain range is Santa Maria de Montserrat, a Benedictine monastery. Taxis and private drivers can be hired to get to Montserrat.From the mountain top, the views are stunning!View from Montserrat | Montserrat day trip from BarcelonaThe Black Virgin of Montserrat is located inside of the basilica. There is a cafeteria that offers a lunch buffet. Follow a winding, paved trail along the mountain cliffs to the chapel. Here is a post that does a good job explaining the hike, if you are interested.The Stairway to Heaven is a stack of nine large concrete blocks arranged in a helical pattern. You can learn more about the Boys Choir on the official website. In 1811 and 1812, the monastery was attacked and burned down twice by Napoleon's troops. The journey by train takes approximately one hour and five minutes and costs €5.75 one way (€11.50 round trip).Change to the Cremallera, a green railway that runs to the top of the mountain. There are two different train stations that you can use to get to Montserrat and it will help to see them on a map. How to Use This Map: Click the tab in the top left hand corner of the map to view the layers (points of interest and the transportation options). There are now 50 boys in the choir, and they perform here on a daily basis, and around the world.There are two daily performances that are typically held in the afternoon. This can be done at the Tourist Information Office located in Plaça Catalunya.Train and HikingThis is the healthiest and most cost effective way to the monastery. From Plaça Espanya, take the R5 line to Monistrol de Montserrat. It contains artifacts from Egypt, Cyprus, and Mesopotamia, as well as artwork by Catalan artists and French Impressionists such as Renoir, Monet, and Degas.Since it does not contain any historical artifacts from the monastery, a visit to this museum may not be worth it for most people.Hours: 10 am to 4:45 pm, longer hours on weekends and in the summer months Cost: €8 Website: museudemontserrat.comThe Holy Cave of Montserrat once housed the Virgin of Montserrat. The last time we checked, the GetYourGuide tickets were slightly more expensive but they offer a more favorable, and easier, cancellation and refund process.Once you purchase the ticket online, from either source, you will receive a voucher that will need to be exchanged for the actual Tot Montserrat Card.
